


Trail Construction Terminology

Trail Clearing Limits for Trees


SLOPE FINISH:

TRAILBED FINISH:


REMOVE LOOGE ROCK & STONE ON THE TRAILBED SURFACE OVER 2" IN THE SMALLEST DIMENSION,
