Can you please provide clarification for the information that Benton County is seeking in the Introductory Letter and the Key Personnel Qualifications sections of the Forest Resources Stewardship Plan Update RFP on page 11? The last 4 bullet points under the "Introductory Letter" requirements (Section 1) are repeated verbatim under the following "Key Personnel Qualifications" section (Section 2). Is it the county's intention to require the same information in both Section 1 and Section 2, or is this a typographical error? In the case of the latter, can you please clarify which bulleted items on page 11 are required components for the Introductory Letter?
- Additionally, are there any guidelines for "Section 9 Appropriate Resources" (page 13)? What are examples of appropriate resources that the county would like to see?
